Executive Overview

Beginning 1 April 2022, Mastercard will offer issuers both 6 and 8-digit bank identification numbers (BINs). Mastercard will also allow issuers to convert existing 6-digit BINs to 8-digit BINs.

Effective Date Details

Date	Details
1 April 2022	Mastercard will revise its fees for various 6-digit BIN fees and is introducing fees for 8-digit BINs.
1 January 2023	Mastercard will revise its Monthly BIN Management fee for 6-digit BINs.

What Mastercard is Doing

Mastercard is introducing fees for 8-digit BINs and is revising various 6-digit BIN fees. Existing 6-digit BINs will continue to be billed Monthly BIN Management and Quarterly Low Usage BIN fees at 6-digit BIN rates unless the issuer converts the 6-digit BIN(s) to 8-digit BIN(s).

Background

The International Organization for Standardization (ISO) announced a move to the 8-digit Institution Identification Number (IIN) standard (IIN is the ISO term for BIN) in 2016 (ISO/IEC 7812–1, ISO/IEC 7812–2) and published the new standard in 2017. As announced in "AN 1018—Support of 8-Digit BIN Standard and Account Range Specifications", dated 2 May 2017, Mastercard will conform to the new standard on 1 April 2022 to better support ecosystem-wide consistency for acquirers. Mastercard has mandated acquiring customers and their processors to support the 8-digit BIN standard and transaction processing using the first 11 digits of the primary account number (PAN) effective 1 April 2022. Mastercard issuing customers and their processors are not required to make changes associated with this enhancement, but they are encouraged to follow the new Mastercard acquirer standards.

Issuer Preparations for Pricing Changes

- Pricing changes will affect legacy portfolios of all issuers on 1 January 2023
- New 6 and 8-digit BIN requests after 1 April 2022 will be priced according to new schedule
- Issuers are encouraged at this time to perform analysis and build a deeper understanding of the impacts to their unique portfolio leveraging the tools we have provided
- Mastercard will be releasing further details Q2 2021 demonstrating how to implement account ranges in preparation of the coming 8-digit BIN migration
- 8-Digit BINs and Migrations will be supported starting 1 April 2022 and detailed instructions will follow in a subsequent announcement

Revisions to Additional BIN Assignment Fee

Effective 1 April 2022, Mastercard will:

- Revise the Additional BIN Assignment fee that is charged one-time upon assignment of new 6-digit BINs from USD 2,000 to USD 12,500.
- Introduce a new Additional BIN Assignment fee for 8-digit BINs that is charged one-time upon assignment of a new 8-digit BIN(s) of USD 500. Issuers that convert existing 6-digit BIN(s) to an 8-digit BIN(s) will not pay this fee. Issuers that request a new ICA number will be given an 8-digit BIN with the new ICA number assignment.
- Introduce a New Private Label BIN Assignment fee for both 6 and 8-digit BINs. Assignments of New Private Label 8-digit BINs will be charged a one-time fee of USD 10,000. Assignments of New Private Label 6-digit BINs will be charged a one-time fee of USD 25,000.
- Introduce a Special Request BIN Assignment fee for both 6 and 8-digit BINs. This fee will apply when customers request a specific BIN series. Assignments of New Special Request 8-digit BINs will be charged a one-time fee of USD 10,000. Assignments of New Special Request 6-digit BINs will be charged a one-time fee of USD 25,000.

Acquirer BINs Will Be Renamed Acquirer Reference ID's

Effective 1 April 2022, Mastercard Acquirer BINs will be renamed to Acquirer Reference ID (ARID) and will remain 6-digits. Acquirer Reference IDs will no longer be considered a BIN and will no longer be an ISO defined field. Existing Acquiring BINs will be converted to Acquirer Reference IDs on 1 April 2022. Newly converted Acquirer BINs to Acquirer Reference IDs will not be a fee charged a new ARID assignment fee. BINs used for both issuing and acquiring activity will be split into an issuing BIN and an Acquirer Reference ID.

As Acquirer Reference IDs will replace Acquirer Only BINs, the existing pricing of USD 2,000 will remain unchanged and applied to the assignment of a new Acquirer Reference ID. Acquirer Reference IDs will not be charged a Monthly Management fee or Inactive fee.

Revisions to Monthly BIN Management Fee

Effective 1 April 2022, Mastercard will introduce a Monthly 8-digit BIN Management fee of USD 1.50 per month per 8-digit BIN. This fee will be charged to 8-digit BINs assigned after April 2022 or newly converted 8-digit BINs (from legacy 6-digit BINs). Issuers must convert existing 6-digit BINs to 8-digit BINs to pay BIN management fees at the 8-digit BIN level.

Effective 1 January 2023, Mastercard will revise its Monthly 6-digit BIN Management fee from USD 25 per month to USD 150 per month per 6-digit BIN. Issuers can convert existing 6-digit BINs to 8-digit BINs and surrender unused 8-digit BINs to Mastercard to opt in for 8-digit BIN Management fees and save on their Monthly BIN Management fees. Mastercard recommends that issuers delete/return unused BINs at both the 6-digit or 8-digit level.

Revisions to Quarterly Low Volume BIN North America Region Fee

Effective 1 April 2022, Mastercard will revise the Quarterly BIN Low Volume fee for all Mastercard 6-digit BINs from USD 2,500 to USD 3,750.

The threshold of 1,000 approved Mastercard processed transactions per quarter in a billing quarter will remain the same. Clearing transactions will be used to define this threshold.

Existing 6-digit BINs will continue to be subject to the 1,000 approved transactions threshold at the 6-digit BIN level. Customers have a grace period of one year for newly assigned BINs before they are subject to the 1,000 minimum approved transactions quarterly threshold.

Effective 1 April 2022, Mastercard will introduce a Quarterly BIN Low Volume fee for all Mastercard 8-digit BINs of USD 37.50. The threshold for 8-digit BINs will be 1,000 approved Mastercard processed transactions. The fee will apply to newly assigned 8-digit BINs or 8-digit BINs that were converted from existing 6-digit BINs. Existing 6-digit BINs will not be charged this fee for their 8-digit BINs. An issuer must go through a BIN conversion process and project to convert their existing 6-digit BINs to 8-digit BINs. Newly assigned BINs and newly converted 8-digit BINs (from legacy 6-digit BINs) will have a grace period of 1 year before they are subject to the 1,000 minimum transactions quarterly threshold.

Revisions to Quarterly No Volume (Reserved/Assigned) BIN North America Region Fee

Effective 1 April 2022, Mastercard will revise the Quarterly No Volume (Reserved/Assigned) BIN fee for all Mastercard 6-digit BINs from USD 2,500 to USD 3,750. Customers will continue to have a grace period of one year for newly reserved or assigned BINs. The criteria for the assessment of this fee will remain a BIN that has zero Mastercard processed transactions in the billing quarter.

Effective 1 April 2022, Mastercard will introduce a Quarterly No Volume (Reserved/Assigned) BIN fee for all Mastercard 8-digit BINs of USD 37.50. Customers will have a grace period of one year for newly reserved or assigned BINs. Newly assigned BINs and newly converted 8-digit BINs (from legacy 6-digit BINs) will have a grace period of 1 year before they are subject to the 1,000 minimum transactions quarterly threshold.
