For over six years, the Uniform Mortgage Data Program® (UMDP®) has addressed many industry challenges. The GSEs continue to work together to enhance the UMDP and bring our programs full circle.

### **Uniform Closing Dataset (UCD)**

Fannie Mae will introduce a *flexible new service* to support the collection and delivery of the UCD in September 2016. In addition to accepting the UCD XML file, this service will offer users an efficient way to receive data quality and eligibility feedback messages based on the provided UCD data. ## **Uniform Residential Loan Application (URLA)**

# Rumors are true -- The URLA is being revised!

This summer the GSEs will publish the revised URLA (Fannie Mae Form 1003) along with a corresponding dataset Uniform Loan Application Dataset (ULAD). Upon release, lenders should begin to review these documents to help prepare for the changes coming in 2018. Fannie Mae will also publish the associated DU Specification for the URLA implementation this summer.

### Uniform Loan Delivery Dataset (ULDD)

All lenders must be delivering the <u>ULDD Phase 2 data</u> in Loan Delivery by the June 27, 2016, mandate. Edits associated with the ULDD Phase 2 data will switch from Warning to Fatal in Loan Delivery on June 27. Reference the <u>Loan Delivery Edit Dictionary</u> for a list of these edits. **DU 10.0 Rescheduled** – <u>Desktop Underwriter</u>® (DU®) Version 10.0 will be implemented the weekend of **September 24, 2016.** DU 10.0 will provide enhanced risk management capabilities, operational efficiency, streamlined processing, and much more. View the fact sheet for details.
